Directions to Test Headquarters:

From I-65 Southbound - Take Exit 91 for US-31W North/KY-61 North. Turn left onto KY-61 North/US 31W North/East Dixie Ave. Approx 0.7 miles to headquarters.

From I-65 Northbound - Take Exit 91 toward US-31W/KY-61
Elizabethtown/Hodgenville. Merge onto Western KY Pkwy. Turn left onto US-
31W North/East Dixie Ave (signs for Elizabethtown. Approx 1.4 miles to headquarters.

Bitches in Season May Participate: Bitches in season WILL be allowed to participate in accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations Chapter 2, Section 8. Please keep bitches in season in your vehicle and notify the Test Secretary upon your arrival. Bitches in season will participate only after all other dogs have been tested.

Awards: Each dog passing the test will receive a green rosette and an 8" Danforth Bread plate. Other awards as per the premium.

Requests to Withdraw: Requests to withdraw must be received in writing by the test secretary prior to the day of the test. In the event an accepted entry withdraws prior to the test date, the event secretary shall contact alternates according to their placement on the alternate list, and upon notification, said alternate shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test.

Refund of Entry Fees: Entry fees will not be refunded for any reason other than for alternates who do not run and entrants replaced by an alternate at the test. Such entry fees

will be destroyed within seven (7) days following test date unless accompanied by an SASE in which case they will be returned to the exhibitor.

Tracking Regulation Cautionary Disclaimer: No dogs are to be allowed to be "off lead." Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site.
