TRACKING REGULATION CAUTIONARY DISCLAIMER

No dogs are to be allowed to be "off lead" – due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

Each dog passing the test will receive a green rosette and an 8" Danforth Bread Plate. Those exhibitors completing a suffix title at the National and who desire recognition at an event may claim a "New Title" rosette on the day of competition. Any exhibitor requesting a rosette should be prepared to validate their entitlement. No rosettes will be mailed. Those exhibitors completing a prefix title (CH, GCH, OTCH, POC, RACH, CT, HC, MACH, PACH, AGCH) and who desire recognition at the event should make arrangements to attend the PWCCA Banquet on Saturday evening or send a representative to claim the "New Champion" rosette. Any exhibitor requesting such recognition should be prepared to validate their entitlement. No rosettes will be presented prior to the PWCCA banquet, and no rosettes will be mailed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Entries must be made on an Official American Kennel Club Entry Form, signed by the actual owner or duly authorized agent and accompanied by appropriate entry fee (***separate checks for multiple entries***) in US Funds. Entry fee includes AKC recording and service fees. Please make checks payable to Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of America. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Collection fees will be added to the amount of each returned check. Entries will be acknowledged if a legible email address is included on the entry form. Do not send entries by any method which requires a signature for acceptance. They will not be accepted. ***Cancellation of entries must be made in writing and received prior to the stated close of entries.***

An original, signed, and unexpired Certification must accompany each TD/TDU entry for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD/TDU test. See Tracking Regulations, Chapter 3, Section 2 for specific requirements.

In accordance with the AKC Tracking Regulations, entries shall be accepted up until the official closing date even though the advertised limit has been reached. **A random drawing of all entries to determine catalog order will take place on September 6, 2022 at 7:00 PM Eastern at 891 Red Fern Rd, Campbellsville, KY 42718, and the public is invited. Separate draws will be held for TD and VST tests.** When the limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be drawn in the same manner and assigned a position on the alternate list. In the event the advertised limit is not reached, entries will be assigned catalog numbers in the order in which they were received and a draw will not take place.

Draw preference will be given to 1) Pembroke Welsh Corgis which have not previously earned an AKC TD or TDU/VST tracking title, 2) Pembroke Welsh Corgis which have previously earned an AKC TD or TDU/VST tracking title, 3) All other entries which have not previously earned an AKC TD or TDU/VST tracking title, 4) All other entries which have previously earned an AKC TD or TDU/VST tracking title.

All entries will be notified of their entry status and a Judging Program will be emailed and/or mailed as soon as practical after entries close and the draw is completed. Should you not receive such notification within a reasonable amount of time, please contact the Event Secretary. In the event an accepted entry withdraws prior to the test date, the event secretary shall contact alternates according to their placement on the alternate list and upon notification, said alternate shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test.

Entry fees will not be refunded for any reason other than for alternates who do not run and entrants replaced by an alternate at the test. Such entry fees will be destroyed within seven (7) days following the test date unless accompanied by an SASE, in which case they will be returned to the exhibitor.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
