

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open only to Pembroke Welsh Corgis fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor. **Umbrellas are not allowed on the course during walkthroughs.**

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Bitches in Season and dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size. Limit 10 entries per envelope.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, back of entry form with agreement, and fees, nor will email, telephone or FAX entries be accepted. Overpayments of less than \$10 will not be refunded.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid. *****PLEASE WRITE EMAIL ADDRESS LEGIBLY!!!**
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$30.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- Overnight service **MUST** be mailed through USPS and you **MUST** check **AND** sign the "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED" waiver box, as the Trial Secretary will not be present to sign for your entries.

INVALID ENTRIES

Invalid entries will be returned to the address on the entry form. The following constitute an invalid entry:

- An entry which is missing any AKC required information.
- Entries not on Official AKC forms or on a photocopy of an AKC form without the current AKC agreement on the reverse side or attached to the entry form.
- Entries which are illegible or incomplete or received with insufficient fees.
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, e-mail, telephone, FAX, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

We answer all correspondence and acknowledge receipt of all move-ups and corrections to entries. We usually respond within 2 days unless we are at a trial. Please contact us if you do not hear back in a reasonable timeframe.

REFUNDS

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

Bitches In Season: Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$12.00 per day of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. **Injuries:** The club will refund all but \$12.00 per day of the entry fee due to injury that prevents participation. The Trial Secretary must written notification from a veterinarian of such a claim before judging commences.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Dogs must qualify to receive awards. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Placement rosettes and pewter plates with the club seal will be rewarded for 1st through 4th place in each class in each height division. New title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing an agility title at this trial. All prizes must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed. Dogs receiving a AGCH, MACH or PACH will receive an award bar. Please contact the trial chair at janeplier@gmail.com if you think you may complete one of these titles at this trial.

Special Agility Prizes

MACH4 High Flyer Ceridwen CD, TD Memorial Challenge Trophy

Honoring Ceri, the first Pembroke Welsh Corgi to earn a MACH, the trophy is a framed glass mosaic depicting Ceri performing the weave poles during her MACH run. Created and donated to the PWCCA by Yvette Huesler, the mosaic sits in a solid walnut base harvested, designed and constructed by Mark Duberstein. This trophy is awarded annually at the Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of America National Specialty Agility Trial. It is awarded to the Pembroke Welsh Corgi that qualifies from both the Excellent/Masters Standard and the Excellent/Masters Jumpers with Weaves classes (preferred classes are not eligible), with the combined most yards per second as determined by the agility trial secretary computer program. For permanent possession, the trophy must be won three times by the identical owner(s), not necessarily with the same dog. Retired in September 2019 by MACH3 Cibola True Enough HSAs, the Ceri Challenge Trophy was re-donated by Cibola Kennel, Cindy Traylor and Maureen Flaherty.

The trophy will remain in the possession of the club until it is won outright. A certificate, rosette and 10" Pewter Apple Bowl will be awarded to the winner.

Agility Preferred Award

An Agility Preferred Annual Award is to be given at each PWCCA National Specialty. This award will be offered by the PWCCA and awarded to the Pembroke Welsh Corgi that qualifies from both Excellent/Masters Standard Preferred and the Excellent/Masters Jumpers With Weaves Preferred classes with the combined most yards per second as determined by the agility trial secretary computer program. The winner will receive a rosette and a pewter bowl with the PWCCA seal.

New Title Rosettes

Those exhibitors competing a suffix title at the show and who desire recognition at the event may claim a "New Title" rosette ringside on the day of competition. Any exhibitor requesting a rosette should be prepared to validate their entitlement. No rosettes will be mailed.

Those exhibitors completing a prefix title (example: CH,GCH,OTCH,POC,RACH, CT, HC, MACH, PACH, AGCH) and who desire recognition at the event should make arrangements to attend the PWCCA banquet on Saturday evening or send a representative to claim the "New Champion" rosette. Any exhibitor requesting such recognition should be prepared to validate their entitlement. No rosettes will be presented prior to the PWCCA banquet, and no rosettes will be mailed.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form** must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

PWCCA is offering FEO in **T2B only.**

- FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

2021 PWCCA Agility Trial COVID19 Procedures

PWCCA (Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of America) has put in place the following procedures for our agility trial at Level Up Dog Sports (LUDS).

COVID POLICY

In response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and continual changes to guidelines and requirements, the PWCCA and all event facilities will follow all AKC, City/County/and State guidelines and/or requirements in place at the time of the National Specialty. For the health and safety of all attendees, the PWCCA is requesting that everyone in attendance at the 2021 National Specialty events be **fully vaccinated or test negative within 7 days prior to their first arrival on site.**

In addition, all attendees may also be asked to sign a COVID-19 Waiver upon arrival.

Updates to the COVID-19 protocol, as necessary, will be posted on our website at www.pwccanational.com, shared on the PWCCA National Specialty Facebook Page, and included in the Judging Program, if time allows.

If you do not feel you can comply with any of these requirements please do not enter our trial, we will look forward to seeing you at a future trial.

If you have been vaccinated, masks and social distancing are no longer required on property and in the building.

Unvaccinated exhibitors and guests must be masked at all times.

There will be paper course map copies. Maps will also be posted to the GoneDoggin' website and the Agility Gate app. We will be using the Remind app to send mass text message reminders and the Agility Gate app for an electronic gate. **REMEMBER:** Remind and Agility Gate are only electronic aides.

Exhibitors are still responsible for arriving on time for their walk-thrus and runs.

See Site Information for information on crating in the building. If you plan on running your vehicle, please park so your exhaust does not go into another vehicle.

One way entry/exit as follows: Enter the building on the parking lot side and exit on the other side where the street goes between the buildings.

We will be lining up the next five dog & handler teams to run. Please respect each teams space in the queue. Exhibitors are responsible for arriving on time for their walk-thrus and runs.

LUDS will sanitize equipment and will disinfect all surfaces, including the floor and equipment, before the event using EPA-registered disinfectants.

Please bring with you the following:

- Lunch, Snack & Drinks
- **A leash** that fits in your pocket or around your waist or cross body during your run. Per AKC guidelines: "exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, cross body, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash, this will be scored as "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off of their body, there is no call unless the dog were to grab it." A leash-runner will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
