CHALLENGE TROPHIES:

HERDING HIGH IN TRIAL CHALLENGE TROPHY- GCH DC SUA MAH BEACH BOY HXA_{sdc} HXB_d CHALLENGE TROPHY ("The Wilson") is a bronze sculpture of a Pembroke Welsh Corgi atop a walnut base with three bronze reliefs each with a Pembroke, one with a cow, one with ducks and the other with sheep. The challenge trophy has been donated by Mary Ann Wehmeuller and Judy Hart in honor of DC Wilson. For permanent possession, this trophy must be won three times by the identical owner(s), not necessarily with the same dog. At least one of the wins must be from the Intermediate or Advanced classes. The trophy will remain in the possession of the club until it is won outright.

IN HONOR OF REBA CHALLENGE TROPHY, A bronze study of a Pembroke Welsh Corgi herding sheep mounted on a wood trophy base. Originally donated by Judy Garbarino - Pokies Country Kennel to be awarded to the High Combined qualifying score (all stock, all courses, all days, with at least two qualifying scores being on different stock) winner at the PWCCA National Specialty Herding Trial, in honor of WTCH HTCH HC Pokies Country Gal, HXAsdc HRDIII HTADIII NAP NJP CD TD, "Reba". Retired in October, 2016, by DC Caamora Aston Martin, HSBd HSAC HXAsd BN, "Speed," the Reba Challenge Trophy was re-donated by Vicki Northway, Drifan, and Patricia and Dennis Seifert, Caamora. Commencing with the 2017 PWCCA Herding Trials, competition for the retirement of this trophy will begin anew and must be won three [3] times by the identical owner(s), not necessarily with the same Pembroke. A wooden plaque, donated by Pokies Country Kennel, or Caamora Kennel and Drifan Kennel will be given each year to the winner of the "Reba" trophy to commemorate their win.

*Those exhibitors completing a prefix title (**CH, GCH, OTCH, POC, RACH, CT, HC, MACH, PACH, AGCH**) and who desire recognition at the event should make arrangements to attend the PWCCA banquet on Saturday evening or send a representative to claim the "New Champion" rosette. Any exhibitor requesting such recognition should be prepared to validate their entitlement. No rosettes will be presented prior to the PWCCA banquet, and no rosettes will be mailed. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

The trial secretary is not responsible for lost or unreceived emails. If you have not received a response to an email within 24 hours, please contact the Trial Secretary by phone.

- ✚ All Pembroke Welsh Corgis that are nine (9) months of age or older at the time of the event. Dogs of this breed, only, with PAL/ILP numbers are also allowed to compete
- ✚ E-mail will be used as a primary means of communication if an email address is listed on the entry form unless entrant requests otherwise.
- ✚ Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the official AKC entry form, or incomplete forms are not acceptable.
- ✚ Telegraph, telephone, incomplete or unsigned entries cannot be accepted.
 - All entry fees payable in US funds. **Entries without full fees, signatures and agreement attached will not be accepted.**
 - **Returned checks and postdated checks do not constitute a valid entry.** The Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in the maker's entries being accepted on a CASH ONLY basis.
 - **Errors on Entry Blanks:** Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded, or changes made, in case of any such errors after the closing date, with the exception of move ups.
- ✚ **Alternate List Policy:** When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be placed on an alternate list. This list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered. In Test Classes, alternates will be given priority over dogs eligible to be moved up.
- ✚ **Bitches in Season:** will be moved to the end of the run order in the Test Classes, and will run in catalog order for Trial Classes.
- ✚ No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same type of stock within each Test or Trial. They MAY enter each trial on the same stock and course.

✚ Declination of entries and Refund Policies:

The Herding Committee may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have recourse against the Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of America, Inc., any official thereof, or any judge. If the event(s) cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Extreme weather conditions, including, but not limited to, snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme temperatures, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, livestock, exhibitors, judges and spectators. The well being of dogs, livestock, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the test/trial before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

- ✚ **Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event the dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from competing by action of the veterinarian, judge, or trial committee.
- ✚ PWCCA does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth in the AKC entry form for this event.

COVID POLICY
